Institution profile

The Ministry of Education of the Argentine Republic is responsible for planning, supervising and financing the national education system, guaranteeing access to education in all levels and modalities, including the creation and funding of national universities.

The University Policy Secretariat has set in motion the Argentine University Promotion Program (PPUA for its acronym in Spanish) with the mission of promoting Argentine university activities abroad in line with Argentina's strategic interests, as well as strengthening University-Society relationship and the exercise of citizenship.

PPUA has four priority areas: promoting the University abroad, extension courses, technological linkage and articulation between institutions. For this purpose, PPUA organizes networks and missions of universities abroad, develops the website "Study in Argentina" (estudiarenargentina.siu.edu.ar), carries out actions together with the consortium in charge of awarding the Certificate of Spanish: Language and Use (CELU for its acronym in Spanish), favors the participation of universities in university fairs abroad and supports lines of extension courses, technological linkage and the relationship between universities, the national government and society.
